The total number of pages will be considered after the paper is correctly formatted according to the template.

Every presenter will be given 12 minutes for presentation plus 3 minutes for questions and answers. *The author who has an accepted paper, irrespective of the paper type (full paper, short paper, poster or student paper), must be registered as a participant.*

A maximum of 4 co-authors per paper is allowed.
