**Dr. Stephen Obaro** (Founder & Trustee, IFAIN) (MBBS, FWACP, MRCP (UK) FRCPCH, FAAP, PhD, FIDSA, FPIDSA) is a Professor of Pediatrics, Director of International Pediatric Research Program, and Adjunct Professor with the Department of Microbiology and Pathology at the University of Nebraska Medical Center. He obtained his basic medical training at Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, where he commenced his postgraduate training in Pediatrics before relocating to the United Kingdom. In addition to further training in clinical pediatrics, he obtained a PhD in Immunology at Imperial College, University of London.

Upon completion of his clinical and graduate training in immunology, he worked with the UK Medical Research Council Research Laboratories in The Gambia as Head of Field Station. He obtained additional graduate training in the United States in general pediatrics at Pittsburgh Children Hospital and in a pediatric infectious disease fellowship at Brown University, Providence, Rhode Island. His research interests include host immune responses to infections, development and deployment of vaccines for the prevention of childhood infections. He has established field studies in Nigeria to understand the epidemiology of bacteremic syndromes in children and the risk factors associated with these infections, through funding support from the National Institutes for Health and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. Professor Obaro has published over 140 articles in peer-reviewed journals and 10 book chapters. He is an active member of Infectious Disease Society of America, European Society for Infectious Diseases, and currently co-chairs the Infectious Disease subgroup of the Global Sickle Cell Disease Network. He is a consultant to Accordia International for improving medical education in Africa, and a visiting Professor at a number of University Hospitals in Nigeria. He has serves as a technical adviser to the World Health Organization on childhood immunizations, antimicrobial resistance and vaccines and was a consultant to the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation on Polio Eradication in Nigeria.



Dr. Steve O. Michael is currently serving as Rector and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Danubius University of Galati, Romania.

He has previously served as Executive VP for Academic Affairs & Provost "Integrating CDU Advantage into Health Professions Curricula at Charles R. Drew University of Medicine And Science CDU, a private, non-profit, student-centered, minority-serving, medical and health sciences university.

Dr. Steve O. Michael is the President of the Association for the Global Advancement of Universities and Colleges (AGAUC) and the Interim Executive Director

of the Association of Chief Academic Officers (ACAO)—a national association for provosts and vice presidents for academic affairs.

He was one of the principal founders of the National Association of Diversity Officers in Higher Education (NADOHE) and its first Vice President and Interim President.
